- Community College Institute was very successful yesterday. It was well attended (80 attendees).

III. NASPA Update

- Voting for consolidation begins tomorrow 3/15 – 4/15 (review of eligibility)
- Regardless of the outcome of the vote, the NASPA board has a plan for the continuation of our association.
- If the vote is for consolidation, there will be an interim board comprised of 6 members from each board. If that is the case, John Laws will be on that board.
- NASPA now has a staff member working with community colleges – Tiki Ayiku
- At the National Board meeting, the board approved a new dues structure for community colleges that will save most institutions. A strong commitment from NASPA to support community colleges.
- Membership update – NASPA has over 12,000 members – highest number in history. Institutional members are over 1150 institutional members and there are over 100 community college institutional members.

IV. Division Updates

- One of our goals is to collaborate with the NUFPP program. We were not able to accomplish that last year but we will continue to have this as a goal for next year. (Paulette Dalpes and Maggie De la Teja will work with John)
- NASPA created an On-Line Learning Series – Institutional members can sign in quarterly – the concept is an hour presentation and then there is an opportunity for questions. We will ease this into something for institutional members.
 - i. We need to identify relevant topics and quality presenters
 - ii. Greg Thomas (SSAO) will present on HBCU and CC partnerships
 - iii. The May topic will be a discussion of the role of administrators on social network sites: pro or con as a student affairs professional
 - iv. Writing grants is another topic for on-line series
 - v. Assignments: - send topics and presenters; also consider a new name for on-line learning series
- Look for opportunities to publish for professional development for our members
 - i. Subjects

 - iii. Targeted publications
