FEDERAL UPDATES

The Department of Labor's proposed change to the salary threshold for exempt employees is being closely followed by higher education leaders and NASPA. *Full article here*.

The White House has issued a "Student Debt Challenge" and encourages higher education institutions to sign on by register through the <u>Student Debt Challenge website</u>.

Financial Aid Simplification and Transparency Act of 2015 (S.108) – no action since January 2015. *All bills can be found here*.
