Knowledge Community (KC) Special Interest Fund Application

• At the Annual Conference, the Board approved for Knowledge Communities to raise funds to support KC programming efforts. Five KCs are enrolled: Asian Pacific Islanders, Enrollment Management, Women in Student Affairs, Latinx/o/a, and Gender/Sexuality.

National and Regional Scholarships

- The Jim Rhatigan Fellowships to attend the NASPA Annual Conference will be increased to \$1,000 to better support graduate students attending.
- In 2018, the Foundation will expand the program to include a graduate student from each Region and area (9 total scholarships).

NUFP Program Scholarship

 Due to the success of the fundraising program for NUFP, this fund will expand to include scholarships for new professional alumni to attend the NASPA Annual Conference and other NASPA programs.
